

## **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS OF ELIGIBILITY**

Stanley Mutual is providing fifteen Bursaries of \$500.00 each, application forms may be found at [www.stanleymutual.com](http://www.stanleymutual.com).

### **TO BE ELIGIBLE**

- a) The applicant must be a resident of Charlotte, Sunbury, York, Northumberland, or Gloucester County.
- b) The applicant must show proof of acceptance or enrollment as a full time student at a post secondary educational institution, (college or university).
- c) The applicant must complete an application form provided by Stanley Mutual.
- d) The applicant must submit an essay of 150 words on History and Benefits of Mutual Insurance.
- e) The applicant must return the application forms **by no later than 4:30pm on May 15<sup>th</sup>** to the office of:

- f) Successful applicant(s) must provide a color photo to the Company for publication.
- g) The applicant must not have received any bursary money from Stanley Mutual before (applicants may only receive one bursary from Stanley Mutual).

### **SELECTION PROCESS**

There will be fifteen bursaries each year, with numbers being pro-rated to premium volume per counties of Charlotte, Sunbury, York, Northumberland and Gloucester. Presently, Charlotte County (1), Sunbury County (1), York County (6), Northumberland County (6) and Gloucester (1).
